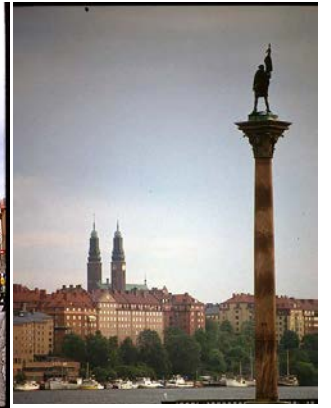

Program Itinerary

Amsterdam, Brugge & Brussels

Day 1

Flight

Overnight flight to Europe. Meals on board of the plane.

Day 2

Copenhagen

This morning arrival in Copenhagen! Copenhagen is Scandinavia's largest and most cosmopolitan capital, has renowned museums and a spiritual music scene.

After going through customs meet your tour escort and bus driver and transfer to the city centre. Have some free time before checking into your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 3

Copenhagen

In the morning enjoy a **walking tour** of this beautiful city. See the City Hall, Amalienborg Palace, Rosenberg Castle and of course the famous little Mermaid. In the afternoon **possible performance** in for example Tivoli or the Great Church. Dinner and overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 4

Copenhagen – Malmö – Kalmar

Today continue your journey to Sweden. Travel via the longest bridge of Europe to the Swedish mainland to Malmö. If you wish you can make a stop here and explore Malmö on your own. Travel on the Kalmar. Kalmar is one of the oldest cities in the country, once it was even the third largest city in Sweden. History is waiting around each corner. **Visit the Kalmar Castle** upon arrival. Check into your hotel afterwards. Dinner and overnight in Kalmar.

Day 5

Kalmar – Stockholm

Check out after breakfast and travel your last stretch to Stockholm, the capital of Sweden. Along the way you will make a stop in Trosa, a picturesque Swedish village. You will have some time here to walk around, stretch your legs and buy lunch. Later in the afternoon continue to Stockholm. Dinner and overnight in Stockholm.

Day 6

Stockholm

In the morning enjoy a **guided tour** of this city. See Stockholm's canals, castles, palaces. This is perhaps the most beautiful city of the Scandinavian capitals, because the crystalline waters which flow through its intersecting canals gives a luminous appearance to palaces, castles and parks.

Performance possible today in one of Stockholm's many famous churches like the Katarina Church or the Luther Church Sct. Erik. Remainder of the day is free to spend.

Dinner and overnight in Stockholm.

Day 7

Stockholm

This morning after breakfast you can enjoy a visit of the **Vasa Ship Museum**. The Vasa Museum distinctively shaped structure on the isle of Djurgården houses one of Europe's great archeological treasures; an almost intact 17th century warship, raised from the sea after three centuries underwater.

Have the afternoon at leisure for some individual sightseeing or last minute souvenir shopping. Farewell dinner and overnight in Stockholm.

Day 8

Departure

Following breakfast this morning, check out of the hotel, load your luggage on the coach and depart for the airport for your flight home.

If you would like a guide for any of these locations, we would be happy to advise the additional costs and make the appropriate arrangements.
- Music stands, risers, keyboards, chairs etc may require an additional charge if requested.
- TQI reserves the right to make alterations necessary due to lack of participation in any custom tour program or festival. Cost will fluctuate when your group size increases or decrease primarily due to transportation utilization.
